

JOYFUL MYSTERIES

(MONDAY & SATURDAY)

1. The Annunciation

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: HUMILITY

And when the angel had come to her, he said, "Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women."

(Luke 1:28)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

2. The Visitation

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: LOVE OF NEIGHBOR

Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and cried out in a loud voice: "Blest are you among women and blest is the fruit of your womb."

(Luke 1:41-42)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

3. The Birth of Jesus

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: POVERTY

She gave birth to her first-born Son and wrapped Him in swaddling clothes and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the place where travelers lodged.

(Luke 2:7)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

4. The Presentation

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: OBEDIENCE

When the day came to purify them according to the law of Moses, the couple brought Him up to Jerusalem so that He could be presented to the Lord, for it is written in the law of the Lord, "Every first-born male shall be consecrated to the Lord."

(Luke 2:22-23)

5. Finding the Child Jesus in the Temple

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: JOY IN FINDING JESUS

On the third day they came upon Him in the temple sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions.

(Luke 2:46)

LUMINOUS MYSTERIES

(THURSDAY)

1. Baptism of Jesus

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: OPENNESS TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

"And when Jesus was baptized, the heavens were opened and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and alighting on Him, and lo, a voice from heaven, saying "this is My beloved Son," with whom I am well pleased."

(Matthew 3:16-17)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

2. Wedding at Cana

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: TO JESUS THROUGH MARY

His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever He tells you." ... Jesus said to them, "Fill the jars with water." And they filled them up to the brim.

(John 2:5-7)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

3. Proclaiming the Kingdom

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: REPENTANCE AND TRUST IN GOD

"And preach as you go, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, cast out demons. You received without pay, give without pay."

(Matthew 10:7-8)

4. Transfiguration

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: DESIRE FOR HOLINESS

"And as He was praying, the appearance of His countenance was altered and His raiment became dazzling white. And a voice came out of the cloud saying, "This is My Son, My chosen; listen to Him!"

(Luke 9:29, 35)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

5. Institution of the Eucharist

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: ADORATION

"And He took bread, and when He had given thanks He broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you." ... And likewise the cup after supper, saying, "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood."

(Luke 22:19-20)

SORROWFUL MYSTERIES

(TUESDAY & FRIDAY)

1. The Agony in the Garden

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: SORROW FOR SIN

In His anguish He prayed with all the greater intensity, and His sweat became like drops of blood falling to the ground. Then He rose from prayer and came to His disciples, only to find them asleep, exhausted with grief.

(Luke 22:44-45)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

2. The Scourging at the Pillar

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: PURITY

Pilate's next move was to take Jesus and have Him scourged.

(John 19:1)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

3. Crowning with Thorns

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: COURAGE

They stripped off His clothes and wrapped Him in a scarlet military cloak. Weaving a crown out of thorns they fixed it on His head, and stuck a reed in His right hand ...

(Matthew 27:28-29)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

4. Carrying of the Cross

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: PATIENCE

... carrying the cross by Himself, He went out to what is called the Place of the Skull (in Hebrew, Golgotha).

(John 19:17)

5. The Crucifixion

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: PERSEVERANCE

Jesus uttered a loud cry and said, "Father, into Your hands I commend My spirit." After He said this, He expired.

(Luke 23:46)

GLORIOUS MYSTERIES

(WEDNESDAY & SUNDAY)

1. The Resurrection

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: FAITH

You need not be amazed! You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, the one who was crucified. He has been raised up; He is not here. See the place where they laid Him.

(Mark 16:6)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

2. The Ascension

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: HOPE

Then, after speaking to them, the Lord Jesus was taken up into Heaven and took His seat at God's right hand.

(Mark 16:19)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

3. Descent of the Holy Spirit

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: LOVE OF GOD

All were filled with the Holy Spirit. They began to express themselves in foreign tongues and make bold proclamation as the Spirit prompted them.

(Acts 2:4)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

4. The Assumption

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: GRACE OF HAPPY DEATH

You are the glory of Jerusalem, you are the splendid boast of our people. God is pleased with what you have wrought. May you be blessed by the Lord Almighty forever and ever.

(Judith 15:9-10)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

5. The Coronation

FRUIT OF THE MYSTERY: TRUST IN MARY'S INTERCESSION

A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.

(Revelation 12:1)

One Our Father, Ten Hail Marys, One Glory Be, etc.

THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

THE APOSTLES' CREED

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to Judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

OUR FATHER

Our Father, Who art in heaven; hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Amen.

HAIL MARY

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

GLORY BE TO THE FATHER

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy.

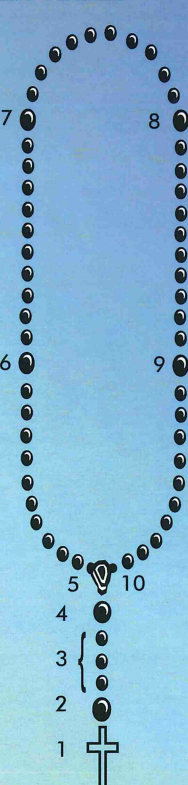
HAIL, HOLY QUEEN

Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope, to you do we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to you do we send up our signs, mourning and weeping in this vale of tears; turn, then, most gracious Advocate, your eyes of mercy towards us, and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of your womb, Jesus. HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the "Apostles Creed."
2. Say the "our Father."
3. Say three "Hail Marys."
4. Say the "Glory be to the Father."
5. Announce the First Mystery; then say the "Our Father."
6. Say ten "Hail Marys," while meditating on the Mystery.
7. Say the "Glory be to the Father."
8. After each decade say the following prayer requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary at Fatima: "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy."
9. Announce the Second Mystery; then say the "Our Father." Repeat 6, 7, and 8 and continue with the Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.
10. Say the "Hail, Holy Queen" after the five decades are completed.
11. As a general rule, the Joyful Mysteries are said on Monday and Saturday; the Sorrowful Mystery on Tuesday and Friday; the Glorious Mysteries on Wednesday and Sunday. The Luminous Mystery on Thursday.
